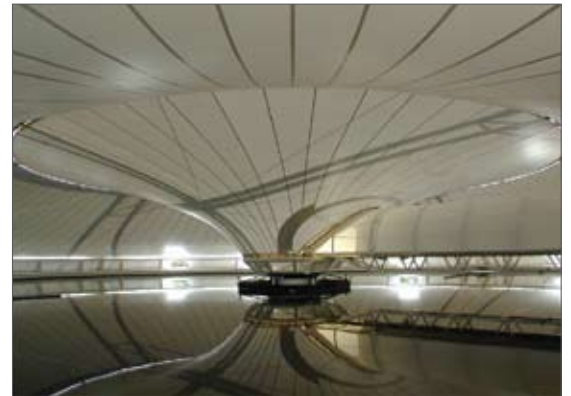

■ Texyloop® in Australia



Innova International is to become the world's first Texyloop® recycling collection centre outside of continental Europe. The Australian Texyloop® collection site will commence operations in late 2009. Following a December 2008 trial that involved the return of PVC materials to Europe for recycling, life cycle analysis consultants EVEA produced a report comparing Texyloop® (in Europe) recycling with landfill or incineration in Australia. The analysis confirmed the environmental benefit of the Texyloop® recycling trial. Innova are proud to have given the 'green light' to Australia's only PVC composite fabric recycling program.
